The Forest View Veterans Memorial Committee sincerely thanks everyone who has supported our Veterans Memorial project. To date, we have received more than \$11,000 in donations. We are grateful to our past and current Forest View residents, neighboring communities, local businesses, and organizations for helping make this project possible.

A special thanks goes out to the Forest View Park District for selling "America 250" T-shirts, the Forest View Fire Department for selling T-shirts in memory of Fire Chief Mark Jones, and the Stickney-Forest View Lions Club and Forest View Park District for sponsoring a Bingo Night and donating all the proceeds to the memorial.

OUR VISION

The Veterans Memorial will be located across the street from the Forest View Fire House. Our fundraising goal is \$75,000 for the initial phase, which will allow us to create a beautiful and lasting place to honor the men and women of our community who have served our country. The centerpiece will be the American flag surrounded by a hexagon-shaped structure representing the six branches of the United States military. The project will also include concrete, benches, landscaping, and monuments honoring those veterans who served our country. We currently have 178 names of past and current Forest View residents who have served our country. We plan to engrave their names on the memorial so that their service and sacrifice will be remembered for generations to come. Phase One is planned for spring 2027.

FOREST VIEW VETERANS MEMORIAL

Our Village was founded in 1924 exclusively by veterans of World War I. More than a century has passed, and it is long overdue to erect a memorial to honor all those who have served in the U.S. military throughout the years.

The Village Board has designated the vacant lot at 4601 Wenonah (across from the Fire Station) to be the location for the new **Forest View Veterans Memorial**.

Our fundraising goal is \$75,000 to complete Phase 1 for dedication this Veterans Day, November 11, 2026.

WATER RATE INCREASE

As you may be aware, the Village purchases its water directly from the City of Chicago. The Village of Forest View has been notified that the City of Chicago will be increasing the amount it charges Forest View residents and businesses per gallon.

Therefore, to offset this substantial increased expenditure to the Village, regrettably, the Village's water rates will be increasing for residents and businesses effective June 1, 2026. The new rate will be a minimum charge of \$117.70 for residential users for the first 9,000 gallons and a charge of \$14.71 per 1,000 gallons over 9,000 gallons.

This increase will be reflected starting with the October, 2026 billing cycle.

 - Maximum of two TVs or monitors (TVs not exceeding 60 inches or 100 pounds)

- Place small electronics in a paper bag or sturdy cardboard box
- Clearly mark "**E-WASTE**" in large letters on the bag or box

Dear Parents and Guardians,

With summer quickly coming to an end and the new school year fast approaching, the Forest View Police Department looks forward to welcoming our students back to school. The safety and well-being of our children remains one of our department's highest priorities as we remind everyone that school safety is a shared responsibility.

Our police department will continue working closely with school administrators, staff, students, and families to promote a safe learning environment. Our officers will be visible in and around our schools as we remain committed to building positive relationships with our students and the entire school community.

Please follow all school traffic patterns and designated drop-off and pick-up areas. Most importantly, avoid distracted driving – **specifically the use of cellphones and/or any electronic devices** -- and be especially cautious around school buses and children crossing roadways, as our officers will have a zero-tolerance policy for use of electronic devices in and around our school zones.

We ask parents and guardians to remind your children to use designated crosswalks, obey all traffic signs, and remain alert when walking or riding bicycles to and from school. Also, please encourage your children to be aware of their surroundings and to immediately report anything that makes them feel unsafe to a parent, teacher, school administrator, or police officer.

Parents, we want you to help us by being patient, attentive, and respectful during the busy morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up periods in and around our schools. A few extra minutes of caution can make a significant difference in keeping our children safe.

On behalf of the entire Forest View Police Department, we wish all students, parents, teachers, and school staff a safe, successful, and rewarding school year. Thank you for your continued partnership and support for helping us keep our children safe.

Public Works Reminders

Falling Leaves

When you start raking those colorful leaves, please refrain from raking them into the street. Although Public



Works runs the street sweeper every week, the excess leaves blown from lawns causes blocked inlet and catch basin grates. This can lead to standing water in the curb gutters and road flooding.

For new residents, leaves are to be placed in **PAPER** yard waste bags or garbage cans with a “Compost Only” sticker affixed to it. “Compost Only” stickers are available at the Village Office at no charge. Place full bags or garbage cans at the curb for Wednesday morning pickup. **NOTE:** *We have FREE paper yard waste bags available at the Village Hall.*

American Flag Disposal

If you have any old, worn-out American Flags, we have a drop-off bin in the Village Hall foyer. Public works will take the flags to a flag disposal mailbox at one of the nearby American Legions.



Fall Projects

We have a few projects still in the works for this year.

Safestep will be out to continue addressing trip & fall hazards by saw-cutting. Using this method instead of removing and replacing saved us about \$30,000 last year.

We will also have half of the town tree-trimmed. We’ve identified the most overgrown blocks and designated them for trimming. We also have 13 dead, dying, or diseased trees that will be removed. **NOTE:** We are all out of new trees. If you would like to be put on the planting list please call and let us know. If there are enough requests we can apply for a grant.

We also have 2 projects out to bid right now.

1. Crack-filling the curbline and any new cracks with a tar-like material on all recently paved roads.
2. Catch basin cleaning – A vac-truck will go to each storm sewer basin and suck out all of the leaves and debris that have collected over time.

Learn CPR—You Could Help Save a Life

The Forest View Fire Department will be offering CPR classes to members of the community. CPR and the early use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) can make a critical difference when someone experiences sudden cardiac arrest.

No previous medical experience is necessary. Contact us and take the first step toward being prepared to help during an emergency.

Fall Fire-Safety Reminders

As temperatures begin to drop, please keep these important safety tips in mind:

- Test your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms every month.
- Replace alarms that are more than 10 years old or are not working properly.
- Keep portable heaters at least three feet away from furniture, curtains, bedding, and other combustible materials.
- Never leave candles, fireplaces, cooking, or outdoor fires unattended.
- Have furnaces, fireplaces, and chimneys inspected and serviced as recommended.
- Never use an oven, grill, or generator to heat your home.
- Keep leaves, decorations, and other combustible materials away from heat sources.
- Make sure your home address is clearly visible from the street so emergency responders can quickly locate you.
- Review your family's home fire escape plan and practice two ways out of every room.
- Once outside during a fire, stay outside and call 911 from a safe location.
